MBC is one of only three museums in the country dedicated to the broadcast history. The 62,000 square foot museum opened in the fall of 2011 and was built to a Gold LEED standard. It features a two-story, glass and steel lobby atrium and four floors of exhibition and event space, including the 4th floor Penthouse Ballroom, the Garden Terrace, the 2nd floor Radio Hall of Fame Gallery, and the 3rd floor Television Gallery.
